PERNAFREDERICK COMMERCIAL REAL ESTATE ARRANGES LEASE RENEWALS AND A NEW SPACE CONTRACT WORTH OVER \$965,000

Founded by Anne Mahlum in 2007, Back on My Feet promotes the self-sufficiency of those experiencing homelessness by engaging them in running as a means to build confidence, strength and self-esteem.

According to Viturello, the group has been located in smaller quarters at 1520 Locust Street since 2009 and will move to 100 South Broad Street in January.
